ABOUT MELTON

The programme was created at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem, launched in 1986 in the USA and 1998 in the UK. In London the programme is offered at the London Jewish Cultural Centre, and supported by the UJIA.

How does the course work?

Students meet once a week. Each class consists of two 1-hour sessions with a break. The course is completed in two years; each year comprises thirty weeks spread over three terms.

What do we study?

A wide range of texts put together by a team of scholars and educators at the dedicated Melton Centre for Jewish Education at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem.

How does Melton differ?

Melton offers university-quality teaching with subsidised fees and without qualification requirements. The unique cross-denominational format encourages dialogue and study in the context of mutual respect, making it truly open to everyone.

Who will teach me?

A faculty of experienced educators. Melton's name and reputation attracts the highest calibre of teachers worldwide.

What is my commitment as a student?

To explore, experience and define the meaning of Judaism. There are no prerequisites, no exams and no homework.

Do I need to know Hebrew?

All texts are presented in English so knowledge of Hebrew is not essential.

THE CURRICULUM

FIRST YEAR

Rhythms of Jewish Living

Why do we do what we do? Explore the elements which make up the Jewish calendar as well as the major lifecycle events which punctuate our Jewish lives. Study the central ideas, beliefs and practices that define communal Jewish life.

Purposes of Jewish Living

What do we believe? The essential philosophical concepts and ideas of Judaism as they unfold in the texts. What makes Judaism unique and gives it meaning and purpose.

SECOND YEAR

Dramas of Jewish Living

What makes us who we are? What are the dramatic developments, experiences and issues defining Jewish historical periods as they are reflected and reported in historical texts.

Ethics of Jewish Living

How do we shape our surroundings? Discuss Judaism's concepts and models of justice, life and death, sexuality and community, with case studies from Talmudic, rabbinic and contemporary literature.

AND BEYOND

Graduate Programme

A choice of graduate programmes is available once you finish the course, including seminars and learning events. You are also eligible to join the Hebrew University UK Alumni Association.

Times and places of classes

Once a week, choose Monday mornings, or Thursday evenings. Classes start in October 2009.

Classes are held at the **London Jewish Cultural Centre**, Ivy House, 94-96 North End Road, NW11 7SX (between Hampstead and Golders Green).
