And the points made by **Hebrew University of Jerusalem** Professors Howard Cedar and Aharon Razin in their contribution to the control of gene expression and cancer research, have seen them awarded the 2008 Wolf Prize in Medicine.

The Wolf Foundation was established by inventor, diplomat and philanthropist Dr Ricardo Wolf. Often referred to as Israel's "Nobel Prize", five annual Wolf Prizes have been awarded since 1978 to outstanding scientists and artists "for achievements in the interest of mankind and friendly relations among peoples, irrespective of nationality, race, colour, religion, sex or political view."
